

Subcontracts Terms and Conditions of Purchase – Part II
Cost-Reimbursement Agreements
FAR/DFARS Clauses – Cost-Plus Purchase Orders for Non-Commercial
Goods and Services Under a U.S. Government Contract

The FAR and DFARS clauses cited below are incorporated herein by reference at the effective version found in Viasat's ("Buyer's") prime contract, or higher-tier subcontract under which this Purchase Order is a Subcontract (the "Prime Contract") or in the event such clause is not found in the Prime Contract, at the effective version found as of the date of this Purchase Order. The listed FAR and DFARS clauses are incorporated herein as if set forth in full text unless made inapplicable by its corresponding note, if any. Whenever said clauses include a requirement for the resolution of disputes between the parties in accordance with the "Disputes" clause herein, the dispute shall be disposed of in accordance with the clause entitled "Disputes" as set forth in Viasat's General Terms and Conditions of Purchase (PR001076). The following changes to the FAR/DFARS clauses are made for incorporation of these clauses into this Purchase Order where necessary to derive proper meaning in a subcontract situation from these clauses: "Contractor" or "Prime Contractor" or "prime contractor" shall mean "Seller," "Contracting Officer" shall mean "Buyer," "Contract" or "Schedule" or "Order" shall mean this Subcontract, Purchase Order or related Schedule and "Government" shall mean "Buyer or the Government." However, the words "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change: (1) when a right, act, authorization or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or the Prime Contract Contracting Officer or duly authorized representative, or (2) when title to property is to be transferred directly to the Government. Any inconsistencies between the FAR/DFARS clauses and the foregoing terms and conditions shall be resolved by giving precedence to the FAR/DFARS clauses.
